

Recipes

Sweet Potato and Leek Soup

Ingredients

2 leeks, sliced
1kg sweet potato, cubed
1 large onion, diced
2 cloves garlic, crushed
1 celery stalk, diced
1 litre chicken stock
1 tablespoon butter
1/2 cup fresh chopped parsley
Salt and pepper, to taste

Method

1. In a large saucepan, melt butter, then add leeks, onion, garlic and sauté.
2. Add sweet potato, celery and chicken stock
3. Bring to the boil, then simmer until sweet potato is soft.
4. Add parsley, salt and pepper
5. Allow to cool then puree.
6. Reheat then serve. Add a dollop of cream before serving.
