As we approach Christmas, we think of those less fortunate than us. We will be assembling Pamper Packs early in December – a date to be decided –so any contributions are welcome.






President Meredith presented Wendy with her 30 year Certificate of Membership at the October meeting. Wendy was a Charter member of the club.
