"October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month, a great time to spread the word and encourage family and friends to be breast aware and keep up-to-date with regular screening. BreastScreen Queensland provides free breast screens for women from the age of 40. Women aged between 50 and 74 years are especially encouraged to attend breast screening every 2 years as research shows women in this age group gain the greatest benefits from regular screening. Services are permanently located at Helensvale, Southport and West Burleigh and some after-hours appointments are on offer. There's no better time than now to look after your breast health and encourage others to do the same. To arrange a free appointment at your nearest BreastScreen Queensland service phone 13 20 50."


